Asymmetrie: material vs immaterial production

- Material Production :
 - close to the field (the feet in the mud)
 - challenged by nature, by reality
 - risky, unreliable
 - far from customer => difficult to value
 - poorly rewarded
- Immaterial:
 - Easier to imagin
 - Easier to promote
 - Rewarded by society & business models

 - Raise political interest => funding / policies



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
